

## **Boundary Commission for England 6 week secondary consultation**

The Boundary Commission for England is holding an independent review of all constituency boundaries in England, and invites you to have your say on its proposals. The 2023 Boundary Review will rebalance the number of electors in each constituency, and the number of constituencies in England will increase from 533 to 543’\*.
